From the Principal

The first section of Parshas Tetzaveh describes all the details of the creation, tailoring and manufacturing of the Bigdei Kehunah (priestly garments).

The Gemara (Zevachim 88b) makes the fascinating statement that the Torah's introduction and description of the Bigdei Kehunah is juxtaposed with that of korbanos in order to equate the two. Just as the Korbanos bring atonement for the sins of the Jewish people, so, too, do the Bigdei Kehunah. For example, the Kesones (tunic) atones for bloodshed, the Ephod (apron) for idol-worship, the Choshen Mishpat (breastplate) for improper judgments, the Tzitz (gold forehead plate) for chutzpah/brazenness, and the me'il (robe) for lashon hara.

Wait, is it that easy? The kohanim wear their clothes and all sins are forgiven? If the Kohen Gadol's wardrobe is in order, we're all set?

One of the late Rishonim, the Akeydas Yitzchak (in Shaar 51), elucidates that when the Gemara says that the garments of the Kohanim are capable of bringing about atonement, it means that each of the garments contains a message regarding a particular sin – and if we focus on that, it can help us avoid sinning in the future. Additionally, it enables us to do teshuva for previous aveiros.

According to the Sefer HaChinuch, a person is affected and transformed by his actions, and his behaviors often follow his thoughts and intentions. The Kohen occupies a unique position to atone for the rest of klal Yisrael, and therefore, the Chinuch explains, it is imperative that he dress in a way that impresses upon him the importance of his role and his job. Therefore, when he wears these special, holy garments, he will glimpse at himself and will be instantaneously reminded that he is an essential and important servant in Hashem's "palace". In the beautiful words of the Sefer HaChinuch (mitzvah 99):

היסוד הקבוע לנו כי האדם נפעל לפי פעולותיו ואחריו מחשבותיו וכנותיו, והשליח המכפר צריך להתפייס כל מחשבותיו וכנותו אל העבודה, על פן ראוי ללבש בגדים מיוחדים אליה. שְׂפָשֶׁפֶת בְּכָל מְקוֹם שֶׁבָּגָפוֹ מִיָּד יִהְיֶה נֹפֵר וּמִתְעוֹרֵר בְּלִבּוֹ לִפְנֵי מִי הוּא עוֹבֵד.

The clothes of Aharon and his sons were made so that the kohanim could officiate before Hashem in holiness, with honor and glory - and to inspire the kohanim to greater mindfulness, concentration and recognition of the monumental task with which they are charged.
