Middos Class & Lessons

A 4th Grade Yom Kippur Lesson We Can All Take To Heart

This Wednesday in the 4th grade Middos Class we did something different. I set out an array of small prizes on my desk and 3 heart shaped lollipops. I asked the students to ask me questions about what was on my desk. Finally, the question I was waiting for: A student said, "Mrs. Mammon can I please have a prize?" I answered with a resounding "Yes!" Another student's hand popped up, asking me for one of the pretty lollipops and I answered, "No, but you can have the green slinky". Students continued to ask for prizes and lollipops and to some requests I answered "yes", or "not this, but that," and some I answered, "soon, maybe in a few minutes". In the end, all the 18 students received something! Some got what they wanted, some got something but not what they wanted, and to some had to wait a few minutes, until they got something. I then asked the children what they thought this activity had to do with Yom Kippur and davening. The lesson we learned is, Hashem has many "prizes" in Shamayim! Health, wealth, babies, toys, etc. The way Hashem set up the world is that we must ASK for what we want and need!! Sometimes Hashem says "Yes", sometimes it's "No," sometimes He answers "that's not what is good for you, I will give you something else", and sometimes it's "soon".

I feel that this is a lesson we can ALL take to heart this Yom Kippur. Ask away! No request is too small or insignificant, and no request is too large for Hakodosh Baruch Hu to fulfill. Sometimes the answer will be yes, sometimes no, sometimes not now, But He is always there listening and waiting for us to ask.


