Dear Parents,

Believe it or not, it is already time to begin preparing for the upcoming school year! Although I'm sure that you've heard all about Derech HaTorah, if you haven't visited us yet, the best way to experience Derech HaTorah is in person. Unless you see our classes in action, it's hard to adequately convey the high standards, truly caring faculty and happy atmosphere that are clearly evident when you visit DHR. If you already have a child at DHR, you know what I'm talking about. If not, I would be delighted to give you a VIP tour!

If you have already decided that you would like to send your child to DHR, please complete the attached application form and return it along with the non-refundable \$250 registration fee per child. If you are still undecided, please call me to set up a time to meet.

Why do we start this process in the spring? We have found that it is incredibly difficult to hire teachers, order textbooks, finalize the number of classrooms needed and buy supplies without knowing how many students will be in each class. Please assist Derech HaTorah (and ultimately, your child) in ensuring a smooth planning process. In order for us to plan accurately for the 2018-2019 school year, and in order for your \$250 registration fee to be applied to your child's tuition, **we must receive the attached form and registration fee by May 1, 2018.**

*Families enrolling more than one child will receive a 20% discount off full tuition on each subsequent child's tuition.

Please note: parents' inability to pay full tuition is not a factor in the admissions process. Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need. Upon receipt of the admissions form and registration fee, (which will be applied to tuition if paid by 5/1/18), we will contact those applying for scholarships and begin the process.
